WORSHIP SCHEDULE

March 25 Palm Sunday 8:30 AM Youngsville
10:30 AM Warren

The Palm Sunday liturgy invites us to march with Jesus into Jerusalem in triumph! Each service will begin with Blessing of the Palms, which we will wave as we celebrate Christ as he enters the Holy City. The liturgy then continues and offers a preview of the Holy Week drama, culminating in a reading of the Passion and the celebration of Holy Eucharist. Trinity's service will begin outside in General Warren Park as we gather with our Roman Catholic brothers and sisters from St. Joseph's for the Blessing of the Palms.

March 28 Holy Wednesday 5:30 PM Warren

Trinity's Wednesday Night worship experience encounters Holy Week, and with mystery and with joy we will contemplate the many stories and steps that make up this most grace filled week.

March 29 Maundy Thursday 7:00 PM Warren

This service celebrates Christ's instruction to us to remember him through the elements of the holy table, the mandate he gave during his last meal with his disciples. Bread and Wine for us now become mystically his body and blood, which feeds us not just in body but also in soul. This time of worship also is intimately connected to the following three days, Good Friday and the Easter Vigil, a connection we honor by closing this service with the solemn stripping of the altar. In this we, having been fed by Christ, prepare our worship space and our souls for the fateful events of Good Friday

Do not miss this most holy night at Trinity.
